I. Welcome, Opening Remarks  
a. CWI Chair Mark Tyler

Chair Tyler welcomed everyone to the meeting, introduced DWD Secretary-designee Amy Pechacek, and thanked everyone for taking time out their schedules to attend today's meeting and remaining involved in the Councils work.

II. State of the State Updates  
a. Secretary's Office

i. DWD Secretary-designee Amy Pechacek introduction

Secretary-designee Amy Pechacek thanked Chair Tyler for his continued work leading the Council and inviting her to introduce herself to the Council. She thanked the Council for their continued work and collaboration on workforce and economic issues to advance the workforce. Secretary-designee presented information on the current state of the Unemployment Insurance system, how the system fared throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, discussed the current unemployment insurance programs, and introduced the advancements in the Google partnership that has been established to provide an expedited review of UI claims and assist in process claim payment determinations. She finished her presentation on a discussion of IT modernization for the UI Benefit System as well as 2021-23 Badger Bounce Back budget items that will focus on preparing the workforce for post-pandemic "new normal".

b. State of the State Budget Address Briefing

i. DWD Asst. Dep. Secretary Danielle Williams

Assistant Deputy Secretary Danielle Williams provided a presentation on the Governor's 2021-2023 Executive Budget regarding several workforce initiatives. These included a briefing on several UI modernization and program policy changes, the Worker Connection Program, Wisconsin Fast Forward investments, Pandemic Recovery grants aimed at supporting the 11 workforce development boards throughout Wisconsin, apprenticeship investments, DVR funding increases and Project SEARCH investments, and other workforce, economic and educational investments that our partners in the WIOA State Plan will be able to continue to engage and collaborate with DWD to further the investment to job seekers and employers.

a. Job Centers + Corrections Partnerships

i. Dr. Silvia Jackson, Becky Kikkert

Dr. Silvia Jackson and Becky Kikkert offered a presentation regarding the continued collaboration between the Departments of Corrections and Workforce Development. Continued collaborations include the Windows to Work program, Correctional Job Centers, Mobile Career Lab, Mobile Training Labs, and the partnership with other internal and external partnership of DWD. Dr. Jackson also described the current landscape of the need for additional opportunities for person in our care for education and training to build their skill set for employment upon release.
