

WDA 02: WIOA Minority Outcomes

Statewide

During Program Year (PY) 2016, minorities statewide experienced lower outcomes in the Adult and Dislocated Worker programs than the entire population of participants. Minorities typically comprise between 30%-40% of the Adult and Dislocated Worker Program.

Milwaukee

Employ Milwaukee (WDA 02) served the most minorities in Wisconsin's WIOA Program. Minorities in WDA 02 comprise most of the program participants (Chart 1). In most indicators, minorities performed higher than the entire population.

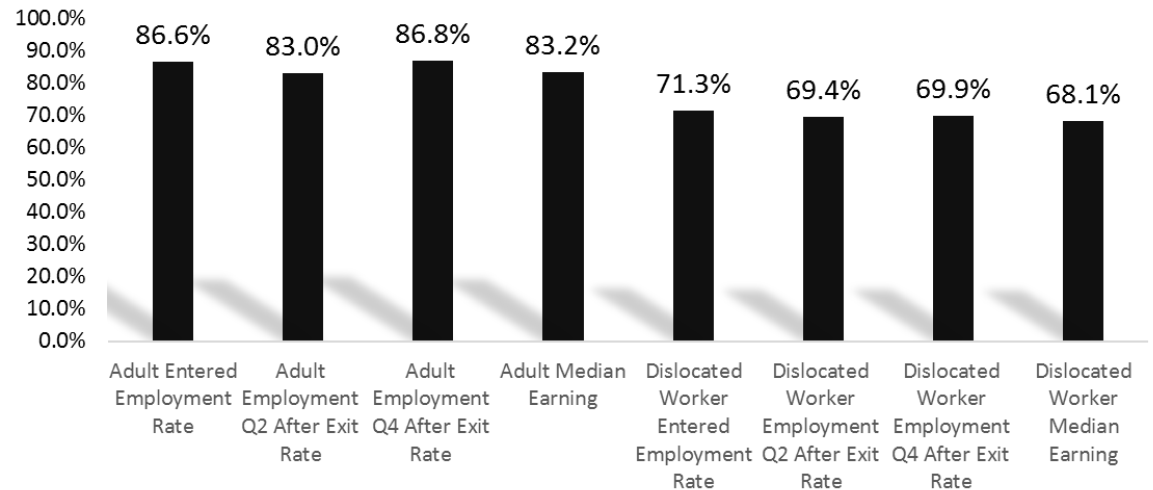

Definitions

American Indian/Alaskan Native: the participant indicates that he/she is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North American and South America (including Central America), and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

Asian: the participant indicates that he/she is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent (e.g., India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Sikkim and Bhutan). This includes, for example, Cambodia, China, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam.

Black/African American: the participant indicates that he/she is a person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.

Employment Q2 After Exit: Of those participants who exit the program the percentage employed at any point during the 2nd full quarter after exit.

Employment Q4 After Exit: Of those participants who exit the program the percentage employed at any point during the 4th full quarter after exit.

Entered Employment: Of those participants who are not employed at the date of participation; the percentage of participants who are employed in the first quarter after the exit quarter.

Hispanic/Latino Ethnicity: the participant indicates that he/she is a person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or Spanish culture in origin, regardless of race.

Median Earnings: The median earnings of participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the program.

Minority: Any individual who self-identifies themselves as a Hispanic/Latino ethnicity, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian, Black/African American or Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander.

Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander: the participant indicates that he/she is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa or other Pacific Islands.
