I. Welcome, Opening Remarks
Mark Tyler called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

II. PY19 WIOA Annual Report – **Action Required**
Bruce Palzkill reviewed highlights from the PY2019 WIOA Annual Statewide Performance Report Narrative due to the U.S. Department of Labor by December 1.

Mark Tyler commented on the UI waiting week study highlighted in the report. During the week people are waiting to receive UI there is not time to access public resources. If there is not a waiting week employers have the flexibility to lay off staff for two weeks and then bring them back. There is also the ability to have two people share one job.

The motion to send the PY WIOA Annual Report to the full Council for review was approved unanimously.

III. PY19 Performance Measures
Aaron Sarbacker and Jeff Orr reported on the PY2019 WIOA performance measures. Morna Foy asked how business customers that have a good experience and are successfully served and do not come back are reflected in the repeat business customer measure. Some employers are constantly looking for employees and others are not. Delora Newton commented that DVRs business service consultants also contribute to this measure but because of COVID the consultants are on loan to UI so there is less staff working in this area. Numbers served have dropped.

IV. Workforce Grants Overview
Bruce Palzkill reviewed several workforce grant initiatives. They include:

- State Apprenticeship Expansion Grant 2020 - \$9 million
- Apprenticeship State Expansion Grant -\$2.6 million
- Support to Communities Grant (Opioid) - \$5 million
- Employment Recovery Dislocated Worker Grant - \$5 million
- Workforce Data Quality Initiative Grant - \$1 million
- COVID-19 Disaster Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant- \$999,000

- H1-1B One Workforce Grant (due early November)

V. Employment & Training Dashboard Overview

Rachel Schwarz gave an overview of the Division of Employment and Training's Employment & Training Dashboard which provides quarterly calculations of individuals served in DWD-run programs and employers who play a role in Wisconsin's workforce.
